THE ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY BOARD of the City of Port Orange was called to order by Chairman La Montagne at 5:18 p.m.

A. DISCUSSION/ACTION

2. Consideration of Minutes

Motion made by Member White to accept the minutes as corrected from the April 26, 2016 meeting. Motion was seconded by Member Young . Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

3. Environmental Position of City Council Candidates.

Jake Johansson, City Manager, addressed the Board regarding their involvement with the City Council Candidates. He advised the Board that they can listen to the views of the Candidates but can't ask questions of them.

Sarah Jones & Don Burnette discussed their views on environmental issues.

4. Historic Tree Removal Mitigation Recommendation / Badcock Home Furniture and More.

Paul Holub, Holub Development Company, is asking the Board for approval to remove three trees from the property.

There was discussion with the Board about what trees will be removed and what landscaping will be put in to beautify the area. There was also discussion about the large trees that will remain on the property. Harry Newkirk, Newkirk Engineering, said there will also be irrigation installed.

Member White would like the wood from the tree removal to be available for any wood carver that would like it.

Motion made by Member White to recommend to City Council the trees be removed with the condition that the wood be donated to a wood carver for a sculpture, donation to the tree bank, and planting the designated amount of

replacement trees. Motion was seconded by Member Klema. Motion carried 3 – 1 with Chairman La Montagne opposed.

5. Tree Seedling Program update

Ms. Momberger has been in contact with the company that produces the seedlings and the optimum time for planting is November to March. She said the company will be able to package the seedlings so they can be kept until the City has an event. Ms. Momberger said the Parks & Recreation Department has some funding and would like to be a part of this project.

Member Klema suggested promoting the seedling program at the Fall Family Day's event and have the seedling give away with the Spring Family Day's.

Ms. Momberger will discuss with Parks & Recreation Staff promoting the seedling program this fall and have the giveaway in the spring.

6. Foxboro Retention Pond Tree Planting

Chairman LaMontagne discussed planting trees in this area. He will get with residents for donations for tree planting. Ms. Momberger said Branford Adumuah, Public Works Director, would like to have any trees planted marked so Staff will know where they are and not mow over them by mistake.
