THE CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP of the City of Port Orange was called to order by Mayor Donald O. Burnette at 6:30 p.m.

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Jake Johansson, City Manager, asked Council to move Item #7 to the beginning of the agenda so the consultants can be excused.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Discussion on Solicitor's Permit Ordinance and Process

Mr. Johansson provided background details of a recent solicitor and asked Council to discuss the process they would like to implement in the future.

Councilman Stiltner discussed his concerns regarding the process. He does not agree with out of state solicitors. He wants a better enforcement process. Matt Jones, Deputy City Attorney, explained an out-right ban would not be legal.

Consensus was to raise the fee and mirror the Business Tax Receipt process, as well as the enforcement process.

5. Half cent sales tax

Mr. Johansson provided details on the funding options for the projects the City needs to complete to help handle the flooding and traffic issues. \$197 million is needed for the projects.

6. Quarterly Financial Report

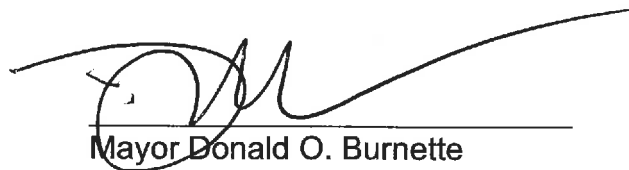
Scott Neils, Finance Director, provided the financial report for the previous quarter.

7. I-95 Gateway Signage

Margaret Tomlinson, Planning and Construction Manager, provided background information regarding the project. Steve Burns, Zev Cohen & Associates, discussed the plan for the signage. He asked Council for consensus on the style. Council would like to see option #3 with the full logo and option #3 with a tree, with color added. Mr. Burns asked Council to discuss lighting options. Consensus on the lighting includes orange back lights with dark letters with font like the "Iowa City" example.

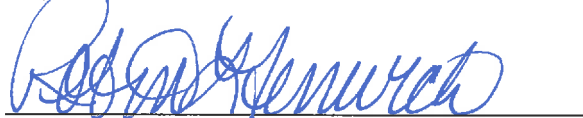
