Mayor Don Burnette read Resolution No. 19-42.

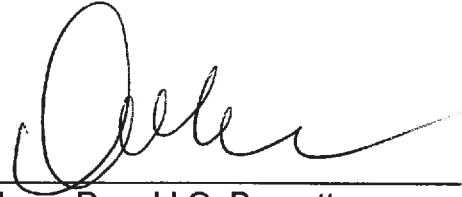
RESOLUTION NO. 19-42

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT POWERS; RATIFYING ALL ACTIONS TAKEN IN PREPARATION FOR HURRICANE DORIAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

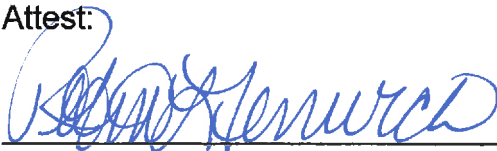
