DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Recognition and Demonstration of the GIS product by Ashlee Malone and Melanie Schmotzer

Jamie Miller, Administrative Services Director, introduced Ashlee Malone and Melanie Schmotzer and thanked them both for their work on the GIS product to showcase current development projects, both commercial and residential. Ms. Malone and Ms. Schmotzer provided a demonstration of the system from the City's website which will go live on November 1, 2019. Council thanked them for their work and will provide feedback once they are able to utilize it.

5. PFM Discussion of Proposed Changes to Investment Policy

Scott Neils, Finance Director, introduced Jason Human, Client Manager for PFM, who discussed the City's current Investment Policy and provided recommendations for changes. Mr. Human answered questions of Council, who agreed the recommended changes as presented were favorable. Mr. Neils will bring those changes back to Council for further discussion and consideration in a revised Investment Policy.

6. County Fire Services Overview on Consolidation

Ken Fustin, Fire Chief, briefed Council on the presentation given by the Volusia County Fire Chiefs Association regarding fire services consolidation at the September meeting of the Roundtable of Elected Officials. He also discussed the recommendations

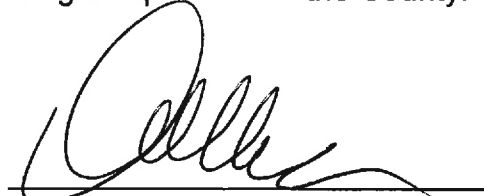
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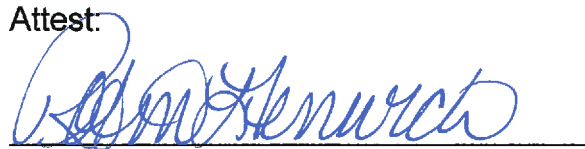

Council is generally not in favor of county-wide consolidation but is happy Chief Fustin is discussing all options with the County.
