RESOLUTION NO. 20-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY COMMENCING MARCH 16, 2020 AT 7:00 P.M.; RATIFYING EMERGENCY MEASURES TAKEN IN RESPONSE TO THE LOCAL EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") outbreak may cause life threatening conditions for the residents; and

WHEREAS, Section 252.38, Florida Statutes, and Sections 26.6.1, et seq. of the City of Port Orange Code of Ordinances provides authority for a political subdivision such as the City of Port Orange to declare a state of local emergency and to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of political subdivisions in order to take whatever action is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 20-52, declaring that a state of emergency exists in every county in the State of Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The COVID-19 outbreak poses a serious threat to the lives and health of the residents of the City of Port Orange. The City Council hereby declares a State of Local Emergency effective on March 16, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. The City Manager shall act as the NIMS Incident Commander and the

Emergency Management Director for the purposes of the COVID-19 outbreak. The State of Local Emergency shall be limited to seven (7) days from the effective date of this Resolution No. 20-12, but may be extended by subsequent resolution or executive order in accordance with Section 252.38, Florida Statutes and Chapter 26 of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. The City Council hereby waives the procedures and formalities required by law of a political subdivision, as provided in Section 252.38, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 26 of the City of Port Orange Code of Ordinances. The Emergency Management Director (City Manager) or the successor, as provided in Section 26.6.4 of the Code of Ordinances, is hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all powers and duties and take all actions deemed appropriate as authorized in Section 252.38, Fla. Stat., and Sections 26.6.1, et seq. of the City of Port Orange Code of Ordinances.

Section 3. The City Council hereby ratifies all emergency measures taken by the City Manager in response to the COVID-19 outbreak local emergency prior to the date of this Resolution.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect on March 16, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.
