DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Hurricane Irma Update

Jake Johansson, City Manager, provided details of the hurricane status, as well as the City's preparations for the storm. Debris Management Site (DMS) 1 and citizen drop-off location is at 407 Oak Street; DMS 2 is located on Shunz Road; and DMS 3 is at 5931 Hensel Road. Flooding concerns were discussed. Mr. Johansson asked Council for consensus regarding private property debris removal. Council agreed to handle the debris removal even though FEMA reimbursement may not occur. Waste Pro plans to maintain their normal schedule after the storm is over.

Mr. Johansson asked Council to consider changes that have happened since Hurricane Matthew, including AquaHawk. He is going to purchase AquaHawk services to watch all accounts for leaks. Fees may be waived based on the same type of ordinance approved during Hurricane Matthew.

He asked Council if they agree with waiving permit fees for Hurricane Irma related damage. Council agreed and would like it to be for 90 days. Mr. Johansson will extend as needed after November 8, 2017.

Mr. Johansson discussed the offer to shelter Daytona Beach Shores and Ponce Inlet employees. Council agreed.

Special City Council Meeting

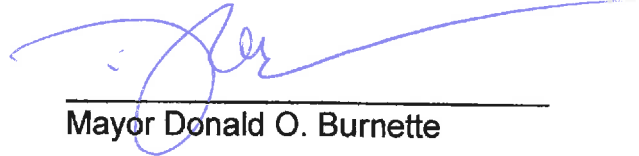
