The Parks & Recreation Advisory Board was called to order by Vice Chairman Cameron at 5:00 p.m.

A. DISCUSSION/ACTION

1. Consideration of Minutes

Vice Chairman Cameron had some corrections to the minutes from the February 17, 2015. He said on page 2 it should state "competitive" not completed, on page 3 should state "bases" not base, and should state "their" not there. Barbara Abbate, City Clerk's office, said she will make the corrections.

Motion made by Member Bowling to approve the minutes as amended for the meeting held February 17, 2015, Seconded by Member Bischoff. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

B. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

C. OLD BUSINESS

2. Port Orange Trails & Sidewalk Map

Tim Burman, Senior Planner, gave a report to the Board. He handed out a map to show where improvements need to be made. Mr. Burman went over some things on the map with the Board. He explained that the City can get some money through TPO grants to

get some of the sidewalks and trails built. He said the TPO would rank the project and perform a feasibility study to determine what improvements need to be made to move forward with the project. That study will be brought to the City to determine if the City wants to move forward. There are some gaps in the sidewalks that the TPO will not fund; those will be up to the City to install. Ms. Lovallo said the map shows what the Board was asking for: connectivity between schools, parks, and shopping.

3. Riverwalk Phase 1 - Groundbreaking

Vice Chairman Cameron asked the Board if anyone had attended the Riverwalk Phase 1 – Groundbreaking. Member Mills-Benat said she did attend and everything was very nice.

4. Sports Complex vs. Community Center

Ms. Lovallo said there has been some discussion with City Council, but the budget is closed for this fiscal year. She said it is in the capital plan but the funding is what City Council needs to discuss further. Member Barraco said a community center is something the City already has, what is needed is a youth center. Ms. Lovallo said a community center would be a multi generation facility, from infants up to seniors.

Member Mills-Benat believes if a community center is multi-purpose there will be a place where children that don't play sports can go. She has been to community centers in West Palm Beach that have big rooms with couches where the children can go just to hang out.

5. Co-Sponsored Teams

Ms. Lovallo said Pop Warner had been working with the City and have a good partnership. Member Mills-Benat said the Soccer Club has started a booster club that she is the Chairman to get on the path for a soccer complex. She said unfortunately the current president of the Soccer Club hasn't been completely on board with a partnership with the City. Member Mills-Benat said he is not willing to do what the City is asking for a partnership.

6. Spruce Creek Kayak Launch

Ms. Lovallo said this is in the capital plan. Member Mills-Benat said there was some talk about building a launch by the bridge on Airport Road where people could pull up and put their kayaks in the water. Ms. Lovallo said because that is a County Roadway, it wouldn't work. Member Bowling said for \$5 you can launch your kayak at Cracker Creek.

7. Foundation update

Ms. Lovallo said the Foundation is on hold until the City has a new City Manager.

D. PARKS & RECREATION DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Lovallo said there is a budget workshop tonight and she will be requesting additional new staff. She said there is also additional monies that are being asked for in the operation budget for Riverwalk. She is also asking for additional funding for programs.

Registrations have ended for soccer and there are 425 children registered; an increase of 40 children from 2014. Ms. Lovallo believes staff is doing a fantastic job increasing marketing. There is a Movie August 14, 2015 at the Amphitheater. Registrations for fall Baseball and Softball have begun. She said the after school program has been very successful. Releveling at City Center is almost complete. Cypress Head Golf Course renovations are complete. Club House renovations were approved by City Council for the architect to complete HVAC design. Cypress Head Restaurant went out for RFP and the presentations are scheduled for August 12, 2015.
