THE CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP of the City of Port Orange was called to order by Mayor Donald O. Burnette at 6:30 p.m.

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DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Discussion of Residential Solid Waste Collection

Lynn Stevens, Public Utilities/Works Director, provided background information on the bid documents, the current level of service, and options moving forward, as well as answered questions from Council. She asked Council to provide direction on the level of service they would like to see moving forward. Council supported remaining at the current level of service with residents providing their own containers.

5. City Hall Tunnel Repair Options

Mrs. Stevens provided background on the City Hall tunnel and the repairs needed and answered questions from Council. The life span of the tunnel is 50 years and the structure is sound; however, the panels need to be replaced. She recommended Option #1 and asked for Council's direction on repairing/replacing the tunnel. Council agreed with Option #1 and asked for "Welcome to City Hall" on the tunnel that possibly lights up. Council Member Scott Stiltner asked for a "brick program" on the walkway in the tunnel. Mrs. Stevens will gather information on the options discussed and will prepare specifications for bidding around August 2021 with award in approximately December 2021 and completion in approximately August 2022.

6. Strategic Plan Implementation Update

Susan Lovallo, Interim Assistant City Manager, provided an update as to the progress of the Strategic Plan Implemented in 2017 and provided items that Staff recommends deleting from the original plan. Council agreed with the removal of key elements as recommended by Staff including the following:

- Push recruitment for public safety educator to focus on hiring Police officers. Review reclass for part time fire Public Educator to full time
- Delete Parks and Recreation Master Plan and include with Comprehensive Plan update
- Delete historic preservation plan and continue with current policy of cataloging any inventory before renovations or removal of inventory
- Delete fiber hubs, private sector can provide at a much cheaper rate and more bandwidth
- Delete incubator opportunities and push to private developers to create space and city to promote

Council wants to see Port Orange University remain in the coming years and to continue to get stronger and stronger.
