Mayor Don Burnette opened the meeting with instructions on proceeding with the interviews and deliberations. Council proceeded with the interviews.

Council discussed their desires in the next City Manager, where the City is today, and what they believe each candidate can bring to meet the goals of the City.

Council voted for their top two candidates as follows:

All five voted for Michael Bornstein and all but Council Member Chase Tramont voting for Wayne Clark. Council Member Chase Tramont voted for Robin Hayes as a top two candidate.

Council discussed their thoughts on Mr. Bornstein and Mr. Clark and how each would benefit the City.

Motion to nominate Wayne Clark as the new City Manager for Port Orange was made by Vice Mayor Drew Bastian and Seconded by Council Member Scott Stiltner. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Motion to authorize the Mayor and City Attorney to negotiate the contract was made by Council Member Chase Tramont and Seconded by Council Member Jonathan Foley.

Council Member Scott Stiltner asked that the contract include a 60-day notice and also include notice to Council if they apply for another position. Council Member Chase Tramont had concerns regarding the notice to Council when they apply.

Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.
