4. Budget Workshop Discussions (City Wide Fee Schedules, Direct & Indirect Fees, Florida Minimum Wage, Enhancements, Cost Allocation, Capital Improvement Plan Request and American Rescue Plan)

Jamie Miller, Deputy City Manager, gave a brief overview of the process tonight.

John McKinney, Finance Director, introduced his budget team, provided a presentation regarding the budget parameters for Fiscal Year 2023, requirements for raising the Florida minimum wage to \$15 by 2026 as approved by Florida voters, requested capital improvement plan projects and potential projects that can be funded by the American Rescue Plan (ARPA) fund as provided by the federal government and answered questions from Council.

Council does not want to see recurring expenses, such as wages, paid for with ARPA money as they are one-time funds.

Robert Reinhalen, citizen, would like the County to pay for a good portion of a new ambulance as he believes we are taking on the responsibility due to their failure.
