4. Budget Workshop Discussion

John McKinney, Finance Director, provided an overview regarding the projects to be used with the American Rescue Plan monies, future assumptions relating to revenues and expenditures, preliminary tax roll details, and a historical review of millage rates and new construction, as well as details on the next steps Staff will be taking relating to the City's budget and what Council will be considering in upcoming meetings and workshops. Mr. McKinney answered questions from Council.

Wayne Clark, City Manager, spoke regarding specific details of the budget process to be discussed at the workshop on July 25th.

Councilman Reed Foley asked for vacancy rates for discussion during July's workshop.

Councilman Chase Tramont would like to consider reserve funds to help balance the budget and to help with inflation costs.

Vice Mayor Scott Stiltner suggested collaborating with neighboring cities to possibly reduce costs on projects.

Councilman Drew Bastian is a bit worried about the real estate market declining and affecting revenues.
