SUBJECT: (B4) Discussion of Riverwalk Property Purchase Offers

DEPARTMENT: Community Development

GOAL: 3 - Quality of Life 4 - Economic Development

RECOMMENDED MOTION: No Action Required

SUMMARY:

In late August, the City's Broker, Colliers International Florida, LLC (Colliers), began marketing the approximately 10 acres of land owned by the City and Port Orange Town Center CRA, located within the Riverwalk area, and the property located along Ridgewood Avenue. Marketing of the site included video, property flyers, real estate ad, email blasts to developers and brokers, and phone calls to other brokers throughout the United States.

As of November 4, Colliers has received six (6) responses from the following groups interested in purchasing and developing the property.

Based on initial discussions with three companies, Colliers and staff began working to set up the November 9 meeting for the Council and the CRA to meet the groups interested in the Riverwalk property. However, after this meeting was set, Colliers received three more inquiries in just over a week, bringing the total number of interested parties to six. Five of the six groups have visited the site or met with staff and have asked extensive questions about the City's vision for the site and have indicated flexibility to work with the city on project scope.

With the three recent responses to the real estate advertisement, Colliers suggested allowing more time for them to analyze all of the proposals to ensure they have consistent information and to work with the interested buyers to add depth to their proposals and provide time for the groups to set up travel to Port Orange and prepare

quality presentations.

It is expected that at the December 7 City Council meeting, Colliers will provide the Council and CRA with an evaluation summary of all the offers received to help the city determine who they would like to invite to a future Council/CRA meeting to present their project in person or to direct staff to begin working on a purchase agreement with a specific group.

Ken Krasnow and David Calcanis from Colliers will be at the November 9 meeting to answer questions the Council and CRA might have about the marketing of the site, the six groups who responded to the real estate advertisement and discuss the evaluation process.
