RESOLUTION NO. 23-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXERCISE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT POWERS; RATIFYING ALL ACTIONS TAKEN IN PREPARATION FOR TROPICAL STORM IDALIA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 23-38 was made by Councilman Scott Stiltner and Seconded by Councilman Tracy Grubbs.

Wayne Clark, City Manager, provided details on storm preparations that have been completed and will continue until storm conditions worsen. Normal City services will close at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, and remain closed until at least 8:00 a.m. Thursday, August 31, 2023. Waste Pro will continue their services on Tuesday but is expected to be suspended once wind speeds reach 35 mph. Sandbags will be available again on Tuesday, August 29, 2023 beginning at 8:00 a.m.
