DISCUSSION/ACTION

3. Consideration of Minutes - October 3, 2023

Motion to approve the meeting minutes of October 3, 2023 as presented was made by Member Lance Green and seconded by Member Michael Bagnato. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

4. Financial and Evaluation Reports from Kemper Sports

Jeff Dayton, General Manager of Kemper Sports, provided an overview of the financials and answered questions from the board.

5. Cart Path and Bunker Repairs

Darren Bache, Superintendent, spoke with Brian Sanderson who is on contract with the city of Daytona Beach. Brian Sanderson will give a quote on the six-inch panels for fixing the spots on the front nine cart paths. Mr. Bache mentioned that half of the money would go to paths and half for the bunkers. Mr. Bache stated that the clubhouse and the driving range needs to be redone. Mr. Bache said that Cypress Head is planning on scheduling the bunker project for the end of September or beginning of October.

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6. Update on Tournaments & Rates

Mr. Dayton stated that the peak season rates will be through May 21, 2024. Mr. Dayton explains that the rates are going up to \$75 and for Port Orange residents it will be \$60. Member Green stated that there will not be a comparison in the rates since other cities will be going up in their prices as well. Member Green asked if there will be many tournaments this time of the year. Mr. Dayton said that there are only a couple tournaments in December and makeup tournaments in January. Chair Lee mentioned that golfers are paying for the quality of the course. Mr. Dayton mentioned that it cost more because of the area, service and quality of the course.

Mr. Bache was checking to see if the meetings were quarterly. Chair Lee and Member Green confirmed that the meetings are quarterly.


BOARD COMMENTS
