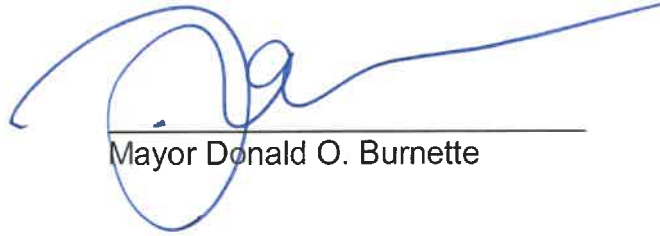
RESOLUTION NO. 24-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXERCISE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT POWERS; RATIFYING ALL ACTIONS TAKEN IN PREPARATION FOR POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE NINE (ANTICIPATED HURRICANE HELENE); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
