

Mr. Sweat provided an update on the project bidding process, confirming that all bids have been received. Down to Earth Golf of Orlando submitted the lowest bid for the bunker renovation. The legal team is preparing the contract, after which Mr. Sweat, Superintendent Darron Bache, and Mr. Dayton will develop a detailed project plan to present to City Council for approval. The renovation is expected to begin in fall 2025, proceeding one hole at a time over 60 to 90 days, and will include drain replacements, re-sodding, and re-sanding.

6. Marketing Update

Ms. House reported that all marketing mailers for Venetian Bay have been distributed, resulting in the addition of several new pass holders. She also noted that a mobile marketing campaign is currently underway, targeting zip codes in Orlando and Georgia to attract golfers seeking new courses to play. Ms. House also noted ongoing efforts to attract a younger demographic, with particular emphasis on promoting ladies' clinics and youth programs and expressed interest in pursuing media coverage to further increase the facility's visibility.

7. Staff Comments

Mr. Dayton reported that 115 children have registered for the Drive, Chip and Putt event scheduled for June 23, 2025. He also noted that golf camp will begin on June 24, 2025, and additional volunteers are still needed to support these events.


BOARD COMMENTS
